Letter from the President

I hope that everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving with family and friends at your side to share it with you!

There were only a few items mentioned at this month's county meeting. The new NH trail map is supposed to be out around the 15th of this month. You should be able to find them at most dealers and at state information centers. I will also try to get some for our January club meeting.

Maine, Vermont and NH are working hard to come up with a Tri State registration--like we had years ago. Hopefully this will become a reality! Unfortunately, it won't be this year.

The three states will again have a reciprocity weekend this year on January 25-27th. Your NH registration will be valid in Maine and Vermont for that weekend only. Just be mindful that you must abide by whatever other requirements each state has regarding snowmobiling. Vermont requires that your sleds are insured and that you carry your insurance card with you when you ride. I believe that if caught operating an uninsured sled last year you paid a

hefty \$600.00 fine! To be safe, remember to become familiar with the laws in each state that you intend on riding in as you plan your trips.

The NHSA Super Raffle will be drawn on December 18th this year so if you'd like a ticket let me know ASAP! The tickets are \$20.00 dollars each with only 1000 tickets printed. The 1st prize is a Polaris sled then three gas cards, a \$500.00, \$200.00 and \$100.00. I'll have some at the Dec. meeting.
