Legislation was passed for the increase but it was too late to be put into effect this year. The new cost next season will be \$64.00 for a resident club member and \$94.00 for a resident non club member. A non-resident club member will be going up to \$84.00 and a non-resident non-club member will be \$114.00 next year. A part of the increase will be going to the Grant-In-Aid fund to help build up the fund to cover maintenance and construction projects for the trails.

October 24th is the date for our annual Flea Market at the Villa Augustina. We may have a new sponsor for this event this year (details are being worked out) and it looks like Toyota will also be

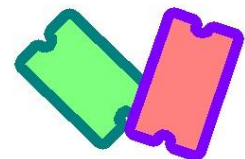

I am still putting together the plans for the fall cleanup and trail work parties. I will be calling people for help when everything is finalized.

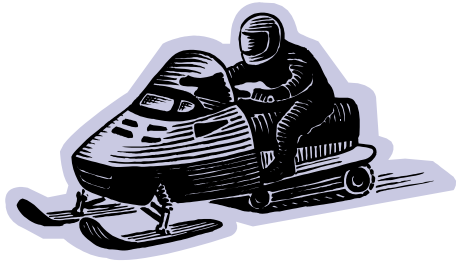

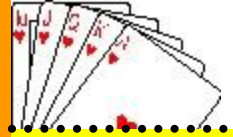
